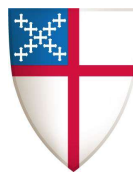
Our Annual Worship and Picnic in the Park

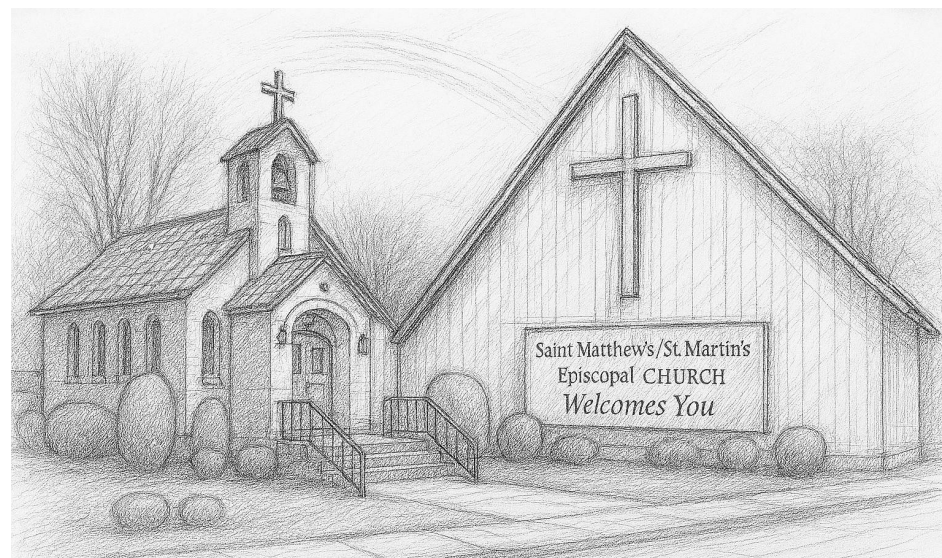

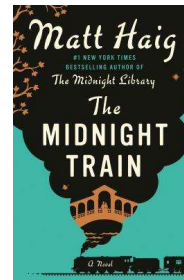
FELLOWSHIP
